

EGG PATTERN as tied by Dave Connolly



Hook: TMC 105, #4 – Egg Fly
Thread: #6 Red, Orange or Clear Mono
Tail: None
Body: Combination Red, Orange or Pink with White Wool Yarn - Dubbed
Bead Head None
Hackle: None
Wing: None
Intended use: Wet fly for Rivers – Cutthroat, Rainbow, Brook and Brown Trout.

Tying Instructions

- 1 – Cut Yarn into lengths of approx. 1/2" inch.
- 2 – Spread yarn out and mix colors to suit taste.
- 3 – Twist into rope with dubbing tool.
- 4 – Wrap over hook to form egg like ball.
- 5 – Tie off and cement.

This fly is great for river fishing when the Salmon are Spawning. Fish deep with fast sink line or shooting head in pools below spawning fish.
