Tail: Pheasant tail fibres

Abdomen: 6 Strands of peacock herl

Thorax: Olive chenille

Shellback: 6 Pheasant tail fibres Swimmerets: 6 Pheasant tail fibres

## **Fly Tying Instructions**

- 1. Wrap on tying thread.
- 2. Tie in the tail of pheasant fibres about the length of the shaft.
- 3. Secure to the butt 4 strands of peacock herl, spin to twist them together then wrap them to a point

about mid-way between the point and the eye. Tie off and trim.

- 4. Tie in the shellback tail fibres in front of the thorax.
- 5. Tie in the chenille, wrap to behind the eye of the hook then tie off.
- 6. Pull the shellback over the chenille thorax, tie off then trim.
- 7. Tie the swimmerets behind the eye of the hook so that the ends are to the point of the hook.
- 8. Form the eye with thread.
- 9. Whip finish.
