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Hook: M 94845 #6 and	
#10	
Thread: Black #8	
Body : 1 dubbing	
2 peacock hurl	Side View
3 metallica (green)	
Hackle: same length as hook	Deer Hair Caddis
gap	
Wing: deer hair	
Tie in thread and finish at the back of the hook, tie in 3 barbs of	
peacock hurl and wind to front leaving lots of room for the head. Tie	
in hackle. Palmer to back and to front, tie off. Cut slope for the hair	
to lie on. Cut "V" on bottom so fly floats in upright position. Stack	

hair, size and fasten with two soft wraps, then 3 tight wraps. Move thread to front Lift hair, wrap several times to make a bump for the hair to rest on Whip finish, 2 or 3 wraps at the point where the wing is connected to the head, do one more whip and then turn the fly over and add one small drop of cement to that same point. (If the head is not cemented, it tends to twist on the shaft after catching a fish or two.
