Hook:	Mustad 94831 #6 to 10 (2XL) or a
	Mustad 80050BR (3XL)
Thread:	Red, yellow, green, black, Uni # 6 or #8
Body:	Red, yellow, green, black antron
Body/wing:	Elk hair
Tail:	Deer hair
Hackle	Brown



Lay a solid layer of thread, tie off and cover in a thin layer of cement. Allow to dry.

Tie in a sparse tail $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{3}{8}$ "long.

#1 - Stack elk hair, trim to length of shaft, place butt end to left of center of shaft and tie in.

#2 - Tie in antron and tie off to right of the elk butts. Tie while pulled up to hide end

#3 - Pull elk hair forward, tie down. Tie in front to help elk hair stand up

#4 - Tie in a brown hackle, palmer once in front of the wing, twice behind and again twice in front to help the wing stand up. Tie off.

Stack another clump of elk and do the last 4 procedures again ending near the eye with enough room to make a small head. See top photo. Cement.
