WHEN—Monday 26th. October

WHERE—Nanaimo River Estuary at the end of Raines rd.

TIME—8a.m. to noon

DIRECTIONS—Drive out the Cedar road and when you cross the Nanaimo river turn left onto Raines rd. Drive to the end, about 2 km. and park by the bird sanctuary.

Don't forget that chums can get up to 15 pounds and can be quite nasty especially if you are hooked so don't bring your 6 wt. rod, if you value it.

The low tide on the 26th is at about 11 a.m. so wading the river shouldn't be a problem and don't forget we will be doing a pub lunch.
