The awards are as follows:



Annual IWFF Awards

1. The annual IWFF Awards selection will be introduced at the October Executive meeting.
2. Presentation of the awards will occur at the December Club Social and Auction.
3. There are five awards and the following guidance is provided.

a. IWFF Member of the Year

- (1) Selected by the President and *another member of the Executive*.
- (2) Criteria:
 - (a) Member in good standing
 - (b) Supports all (?) club activities
 - (c) Promotes a positive and supportive atmosphere
 - (d) Shares personal fly fishing skills with other members
 - (e) Selection is exclusive of the Larry Miller and Tom Skilton awards (general guidance)
- (3) Recognition shall be an engraved tag with the members name and year on the IWFF Member of the Year Plaque. The member may display the plaque at his / her residence for the succeeding year,

b. Larry Miller Fly Fisher of The Year

- (1) Coordinated by the Entertainment Director or a designate appointed in the October Executive Meeting. The selection will be based on the following criteria and s survey of club members.
- (2) Criteria:
 - a. Member in good standing
 - b. Outstanding Sportsmanship
 - c. Commitment to fly fishing
 - d. Receives the most votes by club members
- (3) Recognition shall be an engraved tag with the members name and year on the Larry Miller Fly Fisher of the Year Plaque. The member may display the plaque at his / her residence for the succeeding year,

c. Tom Skilton Conservation Award

- (1) Coordinated by the Entertainment Director or a designate appointed in the October Executive Meeting. The selection will be based on the following criteria and s survey of club members.
- (2) Criteria:
 - b. Member in good standing
 - b. Displayed excellent leadership skills in conservation matters
 - c. Participated in most or all club conservation activities
 - d. Enhanced club conservation activities
 - e. Received the most votes by club members
- (3) Recognition shall be an engraved tag with the members name and year on the Tom Skilton Conservation Award Plaque. The member may display the plaque at his / her residence for the

succeeding year,

d. Bill Brown Literary Award

- (1) Selected by the Newsletter Editor in concert with the IWFF Webmaster.
- (2) Criteria:
 - (a) Submitted by a member in good standing
 - (b) Submission of a written article to the club newsletter, bulletin or IWFF website.
- (3) Recognition shall be an engraved tag with the members name and year on the Bill Brown Literary Award Plaque. The member may display the plaque at his / her residence for the succeeding year,

e. IWFF Photograph of The Year

- (1) Selected by the IWFF Webmaster in concert with the Newsletter Editor
- (2) Criteria
 - (a) Submitted by a member in good standing
 - (b) Submits a photo of any IWFF member or club activity which is informative, humorous or generally appealing.
 - (c) Must be posted to the IWFF website or published in the newsletter or bulletin.
- (3) The member selected for the best photo will be recognized with a framed copy of the submission and an appropriate engraved tag. It is a personal keepsake
