Review of "Top 85 Tips on Fly Fishing for Trout"

When I first popped this DVD into the computer, I was somewhat confused by what I was faced with (a rather common situation for me these days!) but once I figured out the menu, I discovered a vast amount of information available that anybody from beginner to seasoned pro could benefit from.

The menu accessed by clicking on the DVD icon at the bottom of the screen lists a variety of topics of interest and value to fishers focussing mainly on stream fishing. Although the examples are based on American rivers mostly, many of the tips given could be applied to fishing rivers anywhere in B.C., including Vancouver Island.

I wouldn't recommend that you put this video on the big screen TV and make popcorn and have an evening's entertainment in mind. The dialogue is rather boring to listen to, and there aren't many scenes of people catching large trout. This DVD is better watched on your computer screen with use of the menu and the fast forward button to focus on topics of interest to you.

Topics include: Imitating different sources of trout food, reading streams, fishing in different seasons, casting hints, safety suggestions and many more. There is the equivalent of a small encyclopedia of useful information here if you are willing to sift through it!
