Their first stop at Haig-Brown bar showed no other fishers, although one NCA came for a few casts. Sandy Pool had a very few fishers. When our boys moved to the Quinsam, no other fishers were seen. Conditions were excellent ~

Water: very low and clear (C); ditto for the Q (.52 on the gauge).

Air: not super hot in the sun, pleasant in the shade.

No fin nor tail, no head nor scale, of any salmon were noted. The only fish seen were a few smolts or very small trout taking flies of the surface of the Campbell. As the pair were leaving the Quinsam, a chap stopped by to announce that there were very few fish at the hatchery weir and he had seen almost none in the recent past in either river.
