Hey Norm,

I have come across a fellow who has a treasure trove of fly tying materials he wants to sell off. It was the collection of a friend of his who passed away recently. He wants to get rid of it as a lot, not piece by piece.



I went up to Campbell River to view the collection. It looks to be all good stuff, with a wide range of feathers (including jungle cock cape, pheasant and guinea fowl skins and several hackle necks), furs, threads, flashabou etc. Two tying vises, one new, one used. Several fly boxes stuffed with flies. Tying tools, hooks, etc. etc. Most of the stuff is still in the original packaging and is unused. My scan of the lot looked like it would take about \$2,000 to \$2,500 to replace it at retail.



Since you run the Fly Tying with Norm show, I thought you might be interested in getting this stuff for your tying sessions. Perhaps Bob Hammersley would be interested too, for his fly tying evenings with the club. Or one of the club members might like to have it for themselves.



I know that this fellow has been offered \$500 for the lot, which he declined.
