They have had the fish counting fence gates open for a day or so so there should be good numbers of salmon (coho, chum and chinook) above the hatchery now. We did hook some chinook near the hatchery that were in very good shape, but did not manage to land any of them.

Andrew and I both brought home a nice fresh chum each . . . still had sea lice on them when we bonked them.
