Meet at Save On Foods north end at 0715 hours. Carpool to Oyster River facility and meet Jim Loring at 0900 hours at yellow gate off Bear Creek Nature Park loop road.

We will walk down to the hatchery and see the latest project the volunteers are working on. Jim will also spend some time telling us a bit about where and when to fish the Oyster river.
