Glass Bead Pink Flies and Bondic

The other day Ton and I dropped into the JUBU Bead and Gift Shop, #5-120 Alberni Highway in Parksville (open Tuesday to Saturday, 10:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.)

In the store we found 4 colours of translucent UV active glass beads, (green, chartreuse orange and pink) as well as some silvered coloured metal beads. (about 3/16")

Naturally I just had to buy some and at only \$2 a pack for the glass ones how could I go wrong. Of course with the up-coming pink season, hopefully, I just had to tie some. As they are glass and don't do well when they touch gravel on the back cast, when completed I coated the beads with "Bondic", a UV activated resin, with the hope that it would keep the glass bead from breaking. This U.V. activated resin that is currently on sale (p. 28 this week's flyer) at Canada Tire for \$12.99, reg. \$22.99

It's easy to use and comes with resin and U.V. light as a package. Just gently squeeze the black tube and out it comes though a fairly fine nozzle. I've found it good for covering those stick on eyes that always fall off. It hardens quickly and is not tacky.
