Yesterday was such a nice day that I went to Maple Lake. When I got there at 10:30, Claude B was there. The conditions were ideal: sunny, warm and virtually no wind. No insect activity. I was expecting some Chironomid action but nothing. Once in a while, a trout would rise and show its back and take something but I don't know what as there were no chironomid shucks on the surface. I started with a deep full sink line and tried a variety of nymphs, leeches/wooly buggers. Nothing! I then switched to a rolled muddler on a slime line. Nothing! I then tried a floating line with a Griffith's gnat. Bingo! I caught two small 10 inchers. It was a lot of fun to see the fly skate on the water as often the lake was flat calm.

I saw one eagle that looked very majestic flying over the lake and there is also a pair of resident loons. All in all, a good day in the sun.
