

To all volunteers for the fly fishing at NDSS on April 5, 12, 19, 26 (every Wednesday in April).

Please arrive at the school (NDSS on Wakesiah Avenue and Third Street . . . beside the Aquatic Centre.) Please wear your IWFF name tag. Report to the office and a student will guide you to the classroom on the second floor in the Technical Education Wing. The class starts at 830 AM so it might be a good idea to arrive a few minutes before that so you can find your way to the class. I will be going in at 8 AM to set up. Those doing fly casting will be outside!

Students will be divided into two groups of roughly a dozen each with one group doing fly tying for two classes and the other group doing fly casting at the same time. They will swap groups for the third and fourth classes of the series. You do not have to bring anything but your knowledge and patience for working with young people! Ian will be teaching the fly tying with the use of a camera and projector and Don G. will be instructing the fly casting class with the help of his executive voice! It will be your job to help kids with following the instructions they are given and re-teach some things if they don't grasp them the first time. I have assigned people to roughly equal groups depending on their preferences. If someone would like to try their hand at doing the teaching in any of the classes, Don and I would be happy to relinquish the position! Let me know if you can't make any of the classes I have put you with. I will be tying the flies (for my practice!) on Saturday at Oliver Woods.
