


FISHING IN THE FLATS - TROPICAL FISHING TIPS FROM OUR MAN IN BELIZE


This time of year many of us think of taking off to warmer climes, and some of the more fortunate of us are even lucky enough to include our most favourite past-time of fly-fishing in the activities. This winter one of our club members, Mark McGladrey spent a week or so in Belize plying the waters for some of the amazing variety of sport fishes in that wonderful country.

As is the case for any fishing adventure one must prepare beforehand ensuring that you have the necessary equipment and clothing to suit the conditions that you will encounter.

Fishing in Belize one will be faced with warm and humid weather and therefore should dress accordingly. (see photo 1). Also, if one is not successful in the area that you have initially chosen, you must be willingly to change locations and also take a moment to rest in order that you can survive the rigours of a long day by the water. Keep in mind that it is extremely important that one keep hydrated in tropic conditions, as it is so easy when deep in concentration, exerting yourself physically and mentally while on the fish and working the shoals. Here our keen sportsman is ensuring that his fluid intake is sufficient, even while engaged in a delicate drift. (photo1 below). Finally, keep in mind that these tropical monsters are wary and cunning adversaries and you may have to use any method to conceal yourself and sneak up on them as best as possible given the lay of the land. I hope that these tips will help you to be more successful on your next excursion deep into the wilds of the tropics.

Adjournment: 8:30 pm.






