Went out this morning to Neck Point as I had heard that the herring were in the day before.

Upon arriving I saw lots of milky coloured water indicating that a bunch of herring had already spawned. From about 8 a.m. to 9a.m. , casting off the rocks with a herring jig, I caught 11 herring.

Came back at about 10 a.m. with my punt and over the next 90 minutes I caught an additional 17 more.

I also saw a Japanese fellow doing quite well using a long handled salmon net and dipping the herring when they came close to shore to spawn on the sea weed.

They weren't overly big but should make some good pickled herring.
