Don Ginter and myself just returned from the Eve, fish are in but not in the numbers we are used to. Tough fishing, you can have fish right in front of you and they won't bite. We managed to catch about 10 fish over three days, with a lot of casting between bites. The stump run has lots of fish but spooky and with lock jaw. Lower river is the best bet.

A note to members, the log sort is closing for 10 days, roughly the first two weeks of Aug. also they are going to close the road and rip out and replace the two bridges located 2km In from the highway. As I understand they will have a detour. You go past the eve turn off and go another 5 miles to the Eve River rest stop. Get on the logging road and it will take you down to the eve main past the bridge repairs. This is sketchy but the only info I have time and date wise.
