Hi All,

I've purchased three Skagit heads for my single handed rods, 4wt, 6 wt and 8 wt. These rods are all Sage Z- axis 10 foot long. The heads are by OPST (Olympic Peninsula Skagit Tactics) (<u>opskagit.com</u>). As my rods are all 10 feet long, I got the following weights of lines;

- 200 grains for the 4 wt,
- 250 grains for the 6 wt and
- 300 grains for the 8 wt.

The 200 and 250 grain lines are 13.5 feet long and the 300 grain is 15 feet long. These lengths are kept short so that the ratio of the head and sink tips are approximately three times the length of the rod as per recommendations.
