Damsel in Distress

Hook: 10,12 Tiemco 5262 (can be weighted with a single wrap of 0.10 lead wire)

Thread: Light brown works well with the brown marabou and thorax dubbing 8/0

Tail: Medium to Dark Brown Marabou.

Body: continue with same tail feather of Marabou.

Rib: Braided gold tinsel, twisted thin.

Thorax: light, orange, seal fur or lime, green, polar fluff, substitutions such as Angora goat, Ice Dub golden brown.

Wing case: left side of pheasant tailsoft side

Instructions: Attach gold braid. Tie in tail and wrap excess to form body. Wrap rib around body 3 times. Attach pheasant tail for wing case. Add two or three wraps of dubbing to form thorax. Fold feather to form wing case and side wings. Form head and cement for durability. IWFF fly tying demo
