## Crayfish

tied by Bruce Cumming



**Hook** Mustad 9672 # 4 or equivalent weighted with lead wire

**Thread** 3/0 black or to match color of body

**Body** various colors of dark chenile

**Shellback and head** Moose hair - long dark ( tan to black )

**Ribbing** silver wire

Eyes large bead chain

**Hackle** brown

Claws(tail) prepared from Ring Necked Pheasant cape feathers

## **Tying Instructions**

- wrap or lay lead wire on hook and secure
- tie in claws past hook bend
- wrap thread back to eye of the hook and tie in moose hair. Secure along shank.
- tie in chenille to bend of hook
- tie in eyes and silver wire

- tie in hackle by tips
- wrap chenile in figure eight pattern, almost covering eyes, then wrap in the body
- palmer hackle toward eye of hook
- bend moose over the back and secure
- Trim off excess hair leaving approximately 1/4 tail
- wrap silver wire creating segmented body
- secure wire and finish head
