## FLASHBACK, GOLD-RIBBED, HARE'S EAR NYMPH

Hook: Mustad 3906 B #8
Thread: Uni #6 dark brown
Tail: Mallard flank

**Body:** Lead .015,

Gold Uni wire, small Natural Hare's Mask

**Thorax:** Pearl Krystal Flash

Wrap lead 15 turns starting from the back and cover the front 5 wraps with another layer.

Tie down, tie in 5/6 strands of mallard flank, tie in the wire.

Cement whole shaft lightly.

Cut, mix and dub the hare's mask to a point just behind the thick section of lead.

Reverse wrap the wire about 5 turns to thread, tie down.

Tie in 20 strands of crystal flash behind double layer of lead, complete dubbing almost to eye.

Pull Krystal flash to eye and tie down.

Form a head, cement.

When cement is dry, use dubbing needle or brush to make legs only below the Krystal flash.

Options are almost unlimited. Hook size 6 to 16 work in rivers and streams. Use colour appropriate to the region. Green dubbing works best in some of our mountain lakes.
